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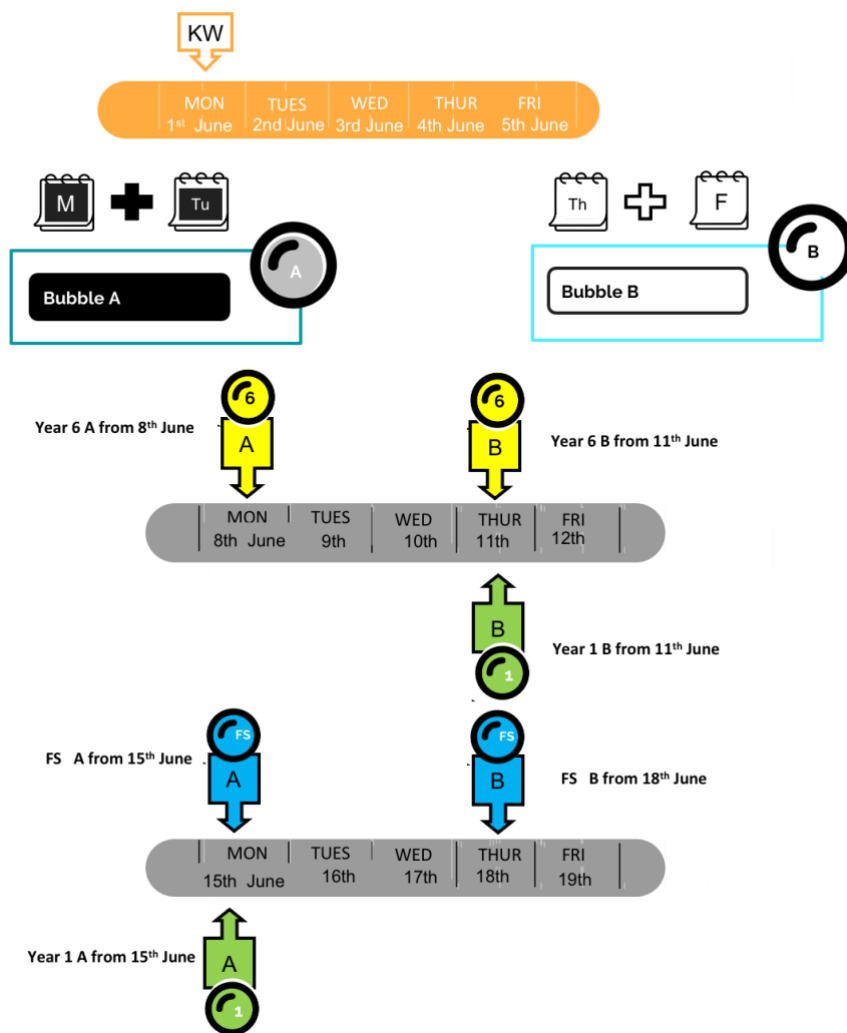

There are some **changes to our expectations** for all those coming into school and so I have also attached our **COVID-19 Home-school agreement**. Please read this carefully with your child.

Please remember that where there are households with members who are shielding we do not expect the children to return.

On the days when groups are not in school please continue with home learning.

Please let us know if you do not want your child's work that is completed at school to come home. We will allow children to bring it home unless you tell us otherwise.

The school cannot guarantee to keep children socially distant, so if you believe this will be a particular difficulty for your returning child please let us know. We also let you know when children are finding it difficult!

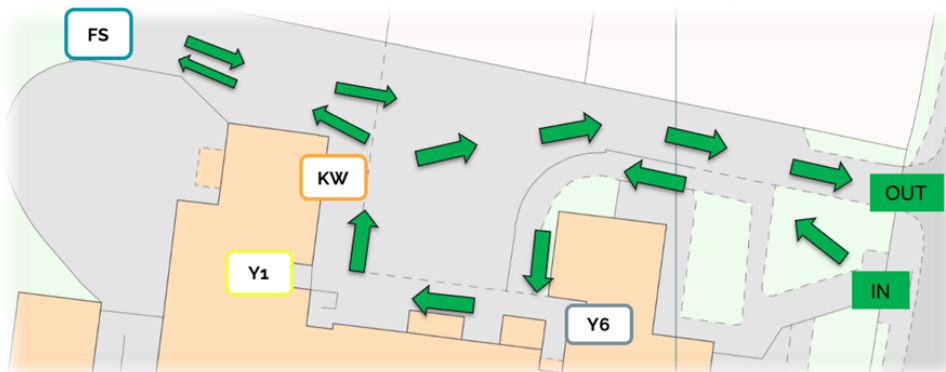
It is important that children do not mix outside of school with others and as a result, if we become aware that some children or families are not adhering to the government guidance we may have to ask them to remain at home.

Finally, the one-way system coming into school and leaving is very important. We need all adults to model the correct behaviour, thank you in advance for your assistance. How will it work?



Access point in and out of the school and one-way pedestrian walk way.



Each group has their own 'kiss and drop off' point as indicated above.



An adult will welcome the children as they arrive.



Children must clean their hands as they enter using hand sanitiser provided.



Cloakrooms will not to be used, instead children will place coats on back of their chair.



School bags, water bottles lunches will be placed under their desks.
