Important dates

Year 1

We have been...

English

- Writing and illustrating our stories
- Using *un* to change the meaning of a word. Eg. *happy* - *unhappy*

Maths

- Beginning to solve problems involving division – using objects to share equally, drawing to solve problems and writing number sentences.

Science

- Recognising and naming everyday materials.

History

- Learning about different jobs in the past and present.

Year 2

We have been...

English

- Identifying key language features found in poems.
- Reading and performing *The Sound Collector* by Roger McGough.
- Collecting sound around the school to help plan their own poems.

Maths

- Identifying and describing the properties of 3D shapes.
- Sorting 3D shapes based on their properties.
- Naming 2D shapes found on the faces of 3D shapes.

History

- Learning about the events that led up to The Great Fire of London.

Science

- Learning about the properties of different materials.
- Planning our own investigation.
