The whole school took part in a 'no pen day' on Wednesday to celebrate Shakespeare week. Infants took part in drama activities and practical science investigations.

Reception

We enjoyed a visit from Louis the Road Ranger and his puppet this week. They taught us all how to cross the road safely. This week we have been counting and ordering numbers to 20 as well as estimating how many eggs were in a basket. We have enjoyed making nests in teams during the forest school session and have continued learning a song about 'The Ugly Duckling'.

Year 1

In Maths this week, we have been drawing pictures to show halves and quarters and have explored problem solving. In English we have been performing the witches' speech from Macbeth and are enjoying sharing George's Marvellous Medicine. We have also been searching for signs of spring as part of our topic 'New Life' and enjoyed using natural resources to create bird nests outside.

Year 2

We have been reading poems this week in English and practised performing 'The sound collector' by Roger McGough. In Maths, we have been adding and subtracting numbers using a range of resources and completed a Maths quiz at the end of the week. In Science, we have been talking about signs of new life.
