This week's learning

Reception

This week we have enjoyed having our parents in for 'Stay and Play'. We have been describing and writing clues to describe our mythical beast which we named 'Ocean Sparkle'. We have been equally sharing and recapping number names and sequencing them. We have designed our theatre boxes and have started making them.

Year 1

This week in Year 1 we have finished creating our mythical creature and have unleashed it into the library! The children have named the creature 'Venomwing' and have written descriptions using some fabulous similes. In Maths we have been exploring place value and as scientists, we have continued our investigations into everyday materials.

Year 2

We have finished making our mythical creature and it is displayed just outside Year 2, come and take a look! In English we have written and edited our own versions of Little Red Riding Hood and in Maths we have been learning about bar models and subtraction. We investigated how the shapes of materials can change in Science by twisting, stretching, bending and squashing.
