This week's learning

Reception

This week we have been using our travel agent role play and recording the World Cup scores each day. We have looked up information about Russia and found it on the world map and enjoyed designing football kits. We have also spent time measuring lengths of string and other items outside in the garden using cubes, rulers and meter sticks.

Year 1

Football fever has hit Year 1! We have been watching some highlights from the World Cup and recording the goals scored. We have also been busy finding and naming the different countries on a world map and have even started a sweepstake. In Maths, as well as recording data we have been revisiting time and money. In Science we have been exploring the different parts of plants.
