This week's learning

Reception

This week we have been finding ways to make ten by adding two numbers. We have been sequencing and retelling the story of 'The Three Pigs' in groups. We have designed and made our mythical creature to display in the main school and have also been enjoying playing in our garden.

Year 1

We have had fun creating fantasy creatures this week and have begun designing and sculpting our own enormous creature! We have used similes and alliteration to describe our creature and in Maths we have been representing place value (tens and ones) in different ways.

Year 2

We designed our own mythical creatures and started work on our whole class creation! In English, we planned our own version of Little Red Riding Hood by changing the characters and will start writing our final story next week. In Maths this week we have been adding numbers using a range of equipment such as Numicon and Dienes.

Please practise the sounds that your child has been learning at school. Encourage them to spot the 'special friends' and use them to blend and read words. Once your child is confident to sound out and blend, encourage them to instantly blend or 'Fred in your head' to read words without sounding out first.
