## This week's learning

### **Reception**

On Monday we enjoyed acting out the story of Saint George using mime and music. We have continued using the story of Peter and the Wolf this week and have made a visual story plan, matched characters to instruments and used symbols for each instrument. The story has been acted out in groups using puppets. In number we have been counting in 2s, 5s and 10s and have been telling and solving number stories. We also made cheese scones using fresh herbs from our garden.

### **Year 1**

In Maths this week, we have been wrestling with number problems and using our number bonds to 10 and 20 to help us solve them. We have been retelling the story of Peter and the Wolf in English and have enjoyed drawing and discussing our favourite characters. We have continued to learn about minibeasts in Science – describing, comparing and sorting them into groups.

### **Year 2**

In English this week we have written reports about butterflies and on Friday started writing the story of Peter and the Wolf. In Maths we have been solving problems involving addition and practised arithmetic. We have continued learning about minibeasts in Science – thinking about their habitats.
