This week's learning

Reception

Our focus this week has been 'Fireworks'. The children have enjoyed exploring ways of representing these. We have also used ribbon wands to dance to Handel's Royal Firework music. We have also spent time observing and talking about ice after the cold spell at the beginning of the week. As a result we have listened to the story of Jack Frost. We watched a performance of the Nativity DVD from last year and have started learning the songs.

Year 1

This week we have been describing the Gruffalo and have created 'wanted' posters in English. In Maths we have been exploring place value and learning about odd and even numbers. We have investigated using our senses in Science and have produced some lovely poppy artwork for Remembrance day.

Year 2

In English this week we have been planning and writing our own version of The Gruffalo. In Maths we have been adding numbers using a range of resources to help us: number lines, hundred squares, dienes and Numicon. In Science we carried out our planned investigation about hand span.
