Reception

The new class is growing as a second intake started this week.

Year 1

We enjoyed creating a scrap book about our class this week; we each had our own page and had to write captions, labels and sentences. In Maths, we have been ordering numbers, counting carefully and adding single numbers using different resources. We have also continued our work on labelling parts of our body.

Year 2

We have been reading 'A Bear called Paddington', exploring the setting of the railway station and imagining how Paddington felt when he first arrived in London. In Maths, we have been revising number bonds to 10 and 20, and using Numicon and 100 squares to help us with addition. We have created a second self-portrait in Art but this time used collage materials to add colour and texture.

In other news...

Years 1 & 2 local walk – As part of their 'Me and my world' topic, children in Years 1 & 2 took Paddington Bear for a walk around the local area on Wednesday. The children helped Paddington spot different features such as parks, roads, houses and shops. Thank you to all parent helpers who attended.
