This week's learning

Year 2

In Maths this week we revised our knowledge of place value and have been adding 2-digit numbers using pictures and resources to help us. In English we read *The Sound Collector* by Roger McGough and have planned our own class version of the poem. We designed our own houses in DT and completed our boat investigation in science.

Ways to support at home...daily reading, Mathletics, adding 2-digit numbers, reading and sharing poems.

Year 1

This week in Maths we have been exploring multiplication by counting in groups of 2 and 10. We will be using this skill to solve practical problems. During our topic work we have been finding out about jobs in the 17th century and deciding which one we would choose. We have continued to investigate everyday materials in science by learning about the work of Charles Mackintosh.

Ways to support at home...daily reading, exploring waterproof and absorbent materials, counting in groups (2s, 5s, 10s), learning about life in the past.

Show and Tell – Each Friday, children may choose to bring something in from home that they would like to show/talk to the other children about. You can help them to prepare by practising what they would like to say.

Reception

This week we have learnt about the life-cycle of a frog and continued to observe the changes happening to the frogspawn in our classroom. We practised counting objects and grouping them into twos. We also explored number bonds to 10 and have enjoyed circle time in the outdoor classroom.
