Year 1

This week in Year 1 we have started our Read Write Inc groups. The children have impressed me with their blending and reading skills. We have had some lovely sentence writing too! We have continued to create pages for our scrap books, drawing and writing about our families and homes. In maths we have been forming numbers accurately and writing number names. In science, we have been labelling the different parts of our bodies.

Year 2
