### Year 1

In maths this week we have been revisiting addition and subtraction. We have been drawing pictures to help us solve problems and have started exploring missing number problems. We will be continuing with these next week. In Dance this week, we have learned an Irish dance with some very tricky fast steps. We have been thinking about our emotions in PSHE and learning ways to describe how we are feeling. As it is almost Chinese New Year, we have been celebrating by watching some dragon dances and making paper lanterns. Gong hei fat choy!
