This week we have been......

- Listening to the story of 'The Rainbow Fish' and talking about how we can share things and treat our friends kindly
- Painting rainbow fish to display in our cloakroom, giving each other one shiny scale
 Taking turns during games and while playing with toys
- Singing songs about rainbows
- Singing alphabet songs and saying the sounds the letters make
- Learning the sounds MASD
- Singing counting songs using numbers to 10
- We have all now made rainbow biscuits during our cooking sessions
