We do lots of things to keep you **safe at school**;

- Make sure that the internet in school only show you age-appropriate information, teach you about internet safety
- Talk about feelings when someone has been unkind or there is conflict so that you can be happy at playtimes
- Make sure that all the adults in school are safe and trained to do their job
- Practice safety at school such as; fire drills, listening to adults, check the play equipment is safe
- We listen to children when they are worried or scared and we work with all the adults to make things better
- We use language of respect with children – their names, no discriminatory terms
- We keep personal information private – only the adults who need to know (who can help) will know
- Have strict rules about photography and filming in school
