As **scientists** we will:

Explore and name a variety of everyday materials. We will work scientifically to sort and classify different objects by their properties.

In RE we will learn about Diwali and the Christian Nativity Story.

Our **Geography** theme is:
The United Kingdom

We will learn to name and locate the four countries and their capital cities that make up the United Kingdom, as well as its surrounding seas. We will focus on Scotland to celebrate St Andrew's Day (30th November).

As **readers and writers** we will: Continue to develop our reading and writing skills with RWI phonics.

Our **PSHE** theme is:
Celebrating Difference.
We will look at similarities and differences between ourselves.



As **designers** we will:
Design and create Christmas decorations and products by upcycling materials.



As **artists** we will:
Use a range of materials to design and create products.
Use drawing and painting to develop and share our ideas, experiences and imagination.
Develop a wide range of art and design techniques using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, space and form.
Learn about the work of Vincent Van Gogh and create our own Starry Night paintings.

As **historians** we will:

Learn about historical events beyond living memory including, The Gunpowder Plot and World War One. We will add these events to our timeline.
We will take part in the remembrance silence on 11th November.

As **athletes** we will:

Practise our football skills and learn gymnastic skills with our specialised coach.

As **mathematicians** we will:

Learn to read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=).
Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20.
Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero.
Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations.
